

Dear Chairman Scott Golden and Members of the Tennessee Republican Party State Executive Committee,

We write you as elected Republicans in Anderson County Government and as Republican Primary voters in the August 1, 2024 election – both voters in support of Rick Scarbrough and Representative John Ragan.

We have been informed that Ragan intends to challenge the August 1, 2024, Republican primary election results. As we understand, while the criteria for consideration of such a contest are unclear, the decision rests with Chairman Scott Golden, and then should it proceed, it will be voted on by the members of the Tennessee Republican State Executive Committee (SEC).

The consideration of this contest will cause irreparable harm to our ability to govern, lead, win, and defend the sanctity of our election process.

We thank Rep. John Ragan for his service to Anderson County and House District 33 in the Tennessee General Assembly. We seek to move forward in honoring that time and his lifetime of service to our nation as an Air Force pilot. While Ragan's decision to contest was decided well before the election and is unfortunate, we hope to mitigate any negative impact this may have on his legacy.

During his time as Clinton Chief of Police, and his continued service to our state as Executive Director for the University of Tennessee's Law Enforcement Innovation Center, we have come to know Rick Scarbrough as an honorable, principled, and effective leader. We know he will serve Anderson County, the people of the 33rd District, and the Republican Party well as our new state representative. Scarbrough won this election because of his tireless work and engagement with Republican primary voters.
